Character

Open since December 2006, Goldman 25hours Hotel revives the former Henninger Hof on Hanauer Landstrasse in Frankfurt. The strikingly colourful façade already gives a first impression of the unconventional hotel world lying beyond. The unique hotel is member of design hotels™ and lies in the vicinity of other projects of real estate developer and visionary Ardi Goldman (also responsible for the Union-Grounds including King Kamehemeha, Sansibar, Das Leben ist schön and the internationally renowned Cocoon Club by DJ Sven Väth).

Goldman 25hours Hotel takes on the lifestyle and trends of Frankfurt's east end and is situated among design furniture stores, creative agencies and insider clubs. Functional design and the love for carefully chosen details are not excluding each other in Goldman 25hours. The public spaces on the ground floor are extraordinary because of their fluent transition into each other and the resulting transparency. Lobby, Lounge, Goldman Restaurant and Bar are multifunctional Spaces able to meet different requirements depending on the time and needs of the day. Apart from this, the living room with its private terrace represents an extra communicative space for the hotel guests. The interior design concept is based on a cheerful eclecticism and playful retro aesthetic with many fancy details and authentic materials. Worth mentioning are the 49 individually decorated guest rooms telling the story of a Frankfurt personality.

Painter Delphine Buhro and sculptor Michael Dreher are responsible for the colourful interior design of Goldman 25hours and have searched design fairs and flea markets for months to collect the countless uniques that give personality to the hotel. Different from its Hamburg sister, Goldman 25hours is neither cool nor pure, but loud and talkative.
